Guidelines for the Students to apply for Concession in Tuition Fees

Eligibility for applying for concession in tuition fees:

- 01. Meritorious students coming from needy family having good academic records are eligible to apply for the concession of tuition fees
- 02. Economically backward student, having Ration Card indicating below poverty, (who has very poor financial background) is also eligible to apply for the concession of tuition fees.

Procedure to apply:

- 01. To apply for concession, total annual family income of a student shall be Rs.1 lakh 20 thousand or less than the said amount. This includes the income of father, mother, sister, and brother and all other sources.
- 02. Economically backward student shall submit a family income certificate issued by competent authority (M.L.A., Savbhapati of Panchayat Samiti, Member of Zilla Parishad, Panchayat Pradhan) within six months from the date of notification as a proof in support of application.
- 03. The student shall have applied / submitted a proposal for educational loan to any bank. A proof for the same is essential that (i) the proposal is under processing Or, (ii) the bank has declined or rejected or not approved the proposal submitted by the student.
- 04. Only tuition fees can be considered for concession.
- 05. Application submission does not necessarily mean that student is eligible for concession. He / She shall have to complete the formalities for admission of the respective academic year.
- 06. Students shall submit copy of requisites as a proof of academic records including other required documents along with the application.
- 07. The concession is valid for the period of one academic semester/year and needy student shall apply every year for getting concession in fees.
- 08. Student availing fee concession from any other organization / agency will be disqualified to apply for this scheme.
- 09.A candidate must be responsible for his or her information given in the application form along with the documents produced by him or her.
- 10 Xerox Copies of all the required documents and the original copy of the income certificate to be submitted with the application form uploaded in the college website and the originals of the same to be produced before the concerned authority in time of counseling.
- 11. Time & Date of submission of forms: 11.30 a.m.- 4 p.m. (except holidays) and Saturday-
